E X T R A C T

1. By direction of the President and pursuant to authority contained in Circular 37, Headquarters ETOUSA, dated 5 April 1945, the following officers, having clearly demonstrated their fitness for promotion by outstanding performance in actual combat, are temporarily promoted in the Army of the United States to grades indicated, effective this date. Date of rank is date of this order unless otherwise indicated after name. These promotions, unless sooner terminated, terminate automatically at the expiration of the emergency and six months thereafter at which time the officers will revert to their permanent grade. No oath of office or acceptance is required. In accordance with the provisions of Public Law 746, 77th Congress, promotion is deemed to have been accepted as of date of this order, and under the provisions of the same law, officers are entitled to receive pay and allowances of the higher grade from such date.
